Beck Quoted in Architect Magazine About What Firms Should Consider When Relocating

Construction services attorney Stanton Beck, Allied AIA, of the Seattle-based law firm Lane Powell agrees: “Certain states have only certain forms of entities—limited liability companies, corporations, or otherwise—that can be practicing architecture,” which could require a business’s legal structure to be changed. In these cases, architects must also take additional steps to close a practice in the state left behind.
